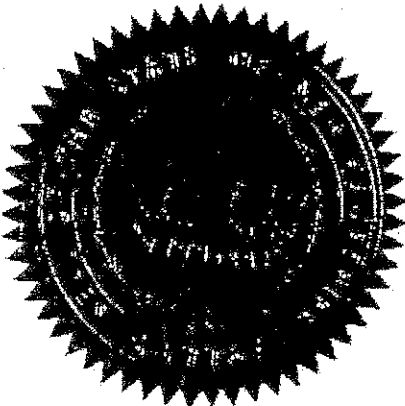
WHEREAS, Advances in technology continually improve options for people with disabilities to obtain employment; and

WHEREAS, Assistive technology allows New Hampshire's seniors to stay active in our communities; and


WHEREAS, Assistive technology helps students with disabilities to access the school curriculum and participate with their peers; and
